ENTRY FORM & TRIAL INFORMATION

Trial Details:

- Tuesday 1st – Sunday 6th of February 2022
- The Open event will commence on Tuesday morning followed by the Novice in the afternoon, this schedule will continue until the conclusion of the Novice.
- Top 20 will be ran on the final day.
- An Encourage event will be ran during lunchtimes.
- Encourage workers can also enter the Novice/Open/Improver
- Affiliated with the VWSDA
- NSW Course to be run under NSW course rules
- 15 Minute Trial
- Entries must be submitted via the entry form and will only be accepted if the declaration is signed

Venue:

Victoria Park, High Street Koroit, Victoria. Only double vaccinated individuals can enter the indoor venue – the clubhouse. Checking of vaccination status will be in place at the entry to the clubhouse throughout the trial.

Accommodation:

Camping is available at Victoria Park for **\$10 per night per powered site**. Please indicate the number of nights you require a camping site and include payment with entries fees. Please note there are no shower amenities available at Victoria Park, so it is recommended that only self-contained caravans are used. Alternate camping is available at Koroit-Tower Hill Caravan Park (55 657 926). Other affordable accommodation is available around the township of Koroit.

Catering:

Light lunches and refreshments will be available each day of the trial.

Trial Dinner:

Dinner and presentation of the TOP 20 will be held on Saturday evening (5th Feb). All competitors and attending persons at the Trial Dinner must be double vaccinated. For catering purposes please indicate on the entry form if you will be attending and include payment with entries fees.
